Week 10: This session is for years 4 and 5

- ☑ Each school to select **4 children for this** session, they need to be able to work independently, cooperate in a group situation and be capable of being used as an expert back at school. They will work on various aspects of camera use and photography techniques.
 - ☑ Each school group will need to **bring their own school camera, complete with charged batteries** (and spares if possible). Laptops will be provided by Bellevue School for the students' use on that day.
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- ☑ The students will be working with 2 teachers, so we envisage that they will not need other supervision for the day. This ensures that we are supporting the empowerment of our "students" and it is their collective work and understanding that is then utilised back at school.
 - ☑ Each school will need to arrange transport for the students.
 - ☑ It is important that the groups arrive at Bellevue School around 8.30am to get settled and make the maximum use of the time available.
 - ☑ A blog (and CD) will be created as a sharing portal for the groups' contributions from the day.
 - ☑ **Students would need to bring their morning tea and lunch**

and use their new found skills in their own schools.*
